About the Charity

- Organization: Friends of Sinai Children (Friends)
A Young Professionals Board benefiting Sinai Children's Hospital
- Designation: 501(c)3 charitable organization. IRS designation letter enclosed.
- Website: www.sinai.org
- Mission: Friends of Sinai Children is a non-denominational, volunteer organization dedicated to developing resources and opportunities that enhance the quality of life of children touched by Sinai Children's Hospital.
- About the Cause: Sinai Children's Hospital provides health care to underserved children who are at greatest risk for chronic health problems, physical and emotional abuse and neglect. As a member of Sinai Health System, Mount Sinai Hospital has one of only four Level 1 adult and pediatric trauma centers in Chicago. Sinai Children's Hospital also has a 39-bed neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) to care for the smallest and sickest babies, some no more than 1 lb. when born. In addition, Sinai also receives transfers from other hospitals that are not able to treat critical pediatric patients.
- Past Funding: Since the group's inception in 2004, Friends has raised over \$300,000 towards vital equipment and programs at the hospital. Over the past 10 years, Friends has purchased a neonatal transport unit which supports the transfer of the tiniest patients to Sinai's NICU; OmniBeds for the NICU, which allows physicians to perform lifesaving surgeries on the smallest of babies in the least intrusive manner possible; an Auditory Brain Response Hearing Machine, a specialized pediatric ultrasound wand and an Olympic Cooling Cap and Infant EEG Cerebral Function Monitor; a Horizontal Airflow Station to filter the airflow in an environment to keep contaminants out when preparing specialty formulas for infants with severe dietary requirements. Most recently, Friends funded the purchase of a Centralized Oxygen Monitoring System as well as refurbished several of the rooms with new television operating systems and sleeper chairs for visiting parents. The group also has support comprehensive services like the Pediatric Weight Management program and Project Advantage which facilitates a safe and effective transition from intensive hospital care to home.
