Nurse Leadership Institute

Purpose

This year's Nurse Leadership Institute will focus on innovative leadership for leading a patient centered culture of safety in your organization. **Kathleen Bartholomew, RN, MN** will be our keynote. Kathleen will offer a fresh and fascinating look at the hospital safety culture and how to maximize the power and resources within the people in your organization. **Karen Cook** with the Studer Group will also present Tuesday afternoon in a session we are calling "Coaching Unplugged." About three to four weeks before the Institute, we will send out a survey to all of the registrants asking them to submit questions for Karen Cook. This should prove to be a very lively and educational session.

The three concurrent sessions on Wednesday will focus on "Rapid Cycle Improvement/Defect Analysis" with **Roger Resar, MD**; "Conversations to Engage Patients" with **Stephen Wegener, PhD**; and "High Reliability and Just Culture: The Big and Small" will focus on how two South Carolina hospitals implemented daily "Safety Huddles" and the impact these have had on patient care.

Thursday, we will hear from four best practice examples in Georgia and South Carolina. At press time, these will focus on care transitions, STEMI, Patient and Family Advisory Councils and Anti-Microbial Stewardship. The program will close with a session from Banner Health in Colorado on the nurse leader's role in creating and sustaining a High Reliable Organization with a Just Culture.

In addition to the excellent educational sessions, there will be time set aside to network and learn from your peers throughout Georgia and South Carolina.

Conference Objectives

Upon completion of this conference, participants will be able to:

- List two qualities required of today's leaders in order to ignite and sustain true culture change;
- Give two example of how you can personally shift the power structure from a hierarchy to a team in your department / organization to create synergy and maximize power;
- Describe two specific actions that you personally can adopt now to lead a patient safety culture;
- Perform rapid cycle defect analysis principles;
- Discuss the importance of patient and family centered safe care through the use of motivational interviewing
- Describe the nurse leader's role in creating and sustaining a high reliable organization with a just culture.

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Who Should Attend

This seminar is designed for nurse executives, chief nursing officers, directors of nursing, staff nurses, and first line managers in hospital nursing including nurse managers, nurse supervisors, assistant directors of nursing, clinical coordinators and clinical nurse specialists.

Registration Information

The cost for this conference is \$295 per person from a SCHA member hospital, GONL member or associate and \$590 per person from a non-GHA/SCHA member hospital. This fee includes Tuesday reception, Wednesday and Thursday continental breakfast, Wednesday lunch, breaks and all conference materials.
