This is a national BSA-developed course that follows the material provided in the latest National Youth Leadership Training syllabus and is modeled after the 21st Century Wood Badge training for adults.


Through activities, events, games and adventures, NYLT participants will work and play together as they put into action the best Scouting has to offer. They will practice and experience leadership skills first hand!
