- A satisfactory recommendation from the Director of the Student Work Program
- A satisfactory State Criminal Background Check and Negative Drug Test
- A satisfactory interview by Teacher Education Committee

Stage 2 - Admission to Student Teaching

- Complete formal application to Student Teaching
- Maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.75 or better
- Satisfactory completion of required clinical and field experiences (Student teaching beginning January 1, 2014 will require documentation of 200 total hours)
- Maintain current required student work performance
- Obtain passing score on the appropriate PRAXIS II and PLT exams
- Be in good standing with office of the Dean of Students
- A satisfactory State Criminal Background Check and Negative Drug Test
- A satisfactory Medical Exam
