

Academic Plan to regain Satisfactory Academic Progress for financial aid

This worksheet will assist you in developing a plan to regain SAP. The qualitative requirement to maintain SAP is to have earned a cumulative GPA of 2.0 and the quantitative measurement is to have earned 67% of your attempted credits.

Step 1. Enter your cumulative credits and your current Quality Points/Quality Hours

The following fields from your transcript must be entered to obtain a calculation
