
Australian Government Solicitor







Section 67 of the Australian Constitution enables the Parliament to make laws for the appointment and removal of civil servants. A person may provide services to the Commonwealth in various capacities – for example, independent contractor or statutory office holder – but it is the *Public Service Act 1999* that primarily governs the engagement of employees of the Commonwealth. The Act also establishes the core terms and conditions of Australian Public Service employment and imposes key duties and obligations on all APS employees and Agency Heads.

The employment lawyers from AGS have prepared an Overview to this pocket edition to give context and explanation to the Act and guide your interpretation and understanding of it.
