The Board of Lincoln County Commissioners met at 8:00 a.m. on July 8, 2013. The following attended: Chairman Ted Lyons, Commissioners Greg King and Doug Stone, County Administrator Roxie Devers, and Clerk to the Board Corinne M. Lengel.

Chairman Lyons called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance, after which Mr. Stone made a motion to approve the minutes from the meeting held on June 28, 2013, as submitted. Mr. King seconded the motion, which carried unanimously.

Mr. King reported attending a barbecue on July 6 held by the District Two road crew. He also received a couple of phone calls since the last meeting, both pertaining to wind tower noise complaints. Both parties informed him they believe it is a private matter between landowners and the wind companies, and the commissioners should not be involved.

Mr. Stone reported checking roads on July 1 and attempting to check where the oil wells are, but having to turn back because of mud in the area. He also checked on the pipeline progress, but no one was working where he went. Ed Anderson contacted him to ask what the county's procedure is for putting a water pipeline across a county road, and Mr. Stone has tried to get back with him, but so far has been unable to. Mr. Stone said he spoke with David Seymour earlier this morning and asked him to see if he could get in touch with Mr. Anderson. Ms. Devers said that he would need to contact the land use administrator and obtain a permit to bore under the road.

Mr. Lyons reported stopping by the landfill on July 3. Mick Jaques seems to be feeling better and they are going to get the mower from the fairgrounds to mow. They also got their posts put in. Mr. Lyons said he'd gone by Steve Monks' oil well and nothing appears to have changed there. He also traveled County Road 2W through Forristalls and commented that the K.C. Electric power line is up to Ravenkamps. On July 5, Dale Bode stopped by to tell him that Brents are now driving on the road coming from the south rather than the one from the east. Mr. Bode put up a no trespassing sign and hired a lawyer. He also called the sheriff and a deputy went up and spoke with him. Mr. Bode's attorney told him that if Brents are caught trespassing they can be sued for damages.

Mr. Lyons also spoke with Fairgrounds Manager Julie Joffe who told him the Thompsons were having their family reunion at the fairgrounds over the weekend and wanted to park closer to the Ellis Allen building than the designated camper parking area. Mr. Lyons spoke with Lawn Thompson who felt the county should have two sets of rules regarding the grounds; one for events with livestock, and one for events without, as the issue seems to be the manure left in the parking area when livestock is allowed there. Mr. Lyons did tell Mr. Thompson they could park where they wanted to until the commissioners decided how to handle it, but asked that they make sure and clean up after themselves. Mr. Lyons asked what the other commissioners thought of coming up with two different contracts or sets of rules. Ms. Devers said she could simply give the parking map to people whose events will have livestock in the parking area and not give it to those who don't. While speaking with Ms. Joffe on July 5, Mr. Lyons said she had also expressed concerns with the septic tank running over. She called Rob Fager and did get

the septic pumped, but was worried because water was running back from the west. Mr. Lyons said he doesn't believe the leach field works properly because it seems like when it gets pumped it drains the leach field back into the tank. He added that they may want to consider having it pumped on the Thursday or Friday of the fair, either early in the morning or late at night.

Ms. Devers said she had some issues with the Coroner's vouchers again; the past board of commissioners required that reimbursement vouchers for deputies depict which calls they went on in order for them to be paid properly. One deputy attending a call will receive \$50, but several times more than one deputy responds to the same call, so they are then required to split the \$50. If the calls are not listed on the vouchers, the commissioners don't know how many deputies responded to the call. Four vouchers were recently submitted that did not show the proper call documentation. Also, the DJ Petroleum bill, approximately \$600, had no trip sheets included with it, as is also required of all other departments when using a county vehicle. Finally, one of the deputies submitted a receipt for a \$26 meal, but the receipt was not itemized, which is also a requirement. Ms. Devers had called Mr. Lyons to ask if he wanted her to email Ms. Nestor about the issues, which he did, and she shared the coroner's response. Ms. Nestor will make sure the deputies write down their mileage and complete the trip sheets properly, and will submit proper, itemized receipts from now on. Ms. Nestor had also lost the back off of her coroner cell phone and wanted to know if she could get a new, upgraded, phone. Ms. Devers had told her to go to the Insignal store and ask them for a new phone back, but she didn't know if she had done so, as Ms. Nestor's email also mentioned the fact that she would like to get a free upgrade for the coroner phone as it is getting very hard for families to hear her and she is not getting cell service in certain areas. Ms. Nestor also asked when the commissioners would meet again so she could come in and go over the purchase of the pins and business cards with them. Ms. Devers said that remaining funds and receipts have not yet been turned in to the Treasurer's office from when Ms. Nestor attended her conference, but the email said she would send her deputy with that and a Worker's Comp claim on Tuesday.

Ms. Devers wanted the commissioners to know that she and Land Use Administrator John DeWitt will both be out of the office the week of July 22, and then stated that she had further information regarding Rob Handley's request to be allowed on ambulance calls as an RN, rather than as an EMT. Mr. Handley had spoken with Vickie Moore, the retired municipal judge for the town of Limon, who concurred with his research. Ms. Devers asked Travis Nall, who is an EMT, if background checks are done each time a person renews their license, but he didn't think so. She also checked with Public Health Director Sue Kelly about background checks on RNs, and Ms. Kelly said she didn't believe they are done that frequently, either. Ms. Devers received an email from Limon Town Administrator Dave Stone asking if it was okay with the hospital that Mr. Handley go on ambulance calls, as Monica Wilkins had refused to let him transport until the issue is resolved. Finally, Ms. Devers said that she had gone out to the fairgrounds and there is already a sign there stating, "No unauthorized use of utility vehicles."

Mr. Lyons said he'd taken a drive the day before and checked on oil activity east of Hugo on 40/287. He added that Kerry Halde had told him that they have minerals all around up by Genoa and may be moving up to that area soon.

The commissioners approved the remaining expense vouchers for the month of June.
