General contractors or their representatives **must** come to the Office of Community Development no later than **4:30 p.m. on Friday February 13, 2009** to formally request copies of the bid documents and proposal Forms. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the bid process on this project.

The Office of Community Development will have final review and approval authority on all bids. Selection of the general contractor will be based upon:

- ✓ Bidder qualifications,
- ✓ Evidence of satisfactory past performance on similar projects, and;
- ✓ Price.

Winning bids will be within +/- 10% of the pre-bid estimate. The bid that is the lowest within this range will be selected unless there is sufficient reason not to select a bid (i.e. poor performance on a recent job). If all bids fall outside this range the bid the City reserves the right to select the bid that closest to the pre-bid estimate or re-bid the project. All contracts and agreements will be executed by and between the City of Attleboro through its Office of Community Development and the Contractor. The property owner may authorize or do work outside the scope of work prepared by the City of Attleboro, during construction, with its own forces or by separate contract.

The Bidder agrees that its bid shall be good for a period of 45 days and may not be withdrawn after the opening of the bids.
