PERSUASIVE TECHNIQUES IN OLD MAJOR'S SPEECH

Problems that are happening in the community	
Who is causing these problems?	
The speech writer's vision for the future – What will the world be like when the problems stop?	
Examples of <u>Alliteration</u> (repeating letters or sounds) Ex: "The cat can't call Claudia."	(One on Page 30)

<p>Examples of <u>Repetition</u> (repeating words or phrases)</p>	(One on Page 28)
<p>Examples of <u>Metaphor</u> (comparison NOT using like or as)</p> <p>“Let our dreams soar on wings of optimism!”</p>	(One on Page 28)
<p>Examples of <u>Rhetorical Question</u> (questions for effect rather than to be answered)</p> <p>“Will we stand now on the brink of history or will we let the moment pass unchallenged?”</p>	(One on Page 28)
<p>Examples of <u>Allusion</u> (historical or literary reference)</p> <p>“Present Kennedy once told us to ‘Ask what we could do for our country.’ And, now is the time to DO!”</p>	(One on Page 32)
