- Create and defend a claim based on your interpretation of the quotation.
 - o A claim is essentially the argument that you intend to prove in your paper.
 - Your claim should clearly state which conflict best proves the quote and provide some insight as to how it does so.

Topics: Select the ONE conflict below that best proves your interpretation of Fosdick's statement. This conflict will be the one that you research for this project.

- World War One (technology involved in weaponry)
- World War Two (nuclear technology)
- Vietnam (communism vs capitalism)
- Israel-Palestine (religion)

Requirements:

- Text-You will be required to use researched information to write a research paper in your own original words. Keep in mind that you will need:
 - o 2.5-3 pages of text
 - MLA format
 - o Parenthetical Citations
 - Works Cited Page
- Sources-You are required to use at least three sourced; however, you may need more than that.
 - Required Sources
 - 1or more library databases (encyclopedia)
 - 1 or more books
 - 1or more primary source
 - Optional Sources (good places to look when you still need more information but have looked in all of the required sourced)
 - Global history text book
 - Time Vault (see Mrs. Nannen for access information)
 - Additional Library Databases

Organization:

You will be given a guided outline to help you organize your research; however, it is often helpful to have a broad overview of what your paper will look like.

I. Introduction

- a. Opening statement
- b. Quote
- c. Interpretation
- d. Explanation or Transition
- e. Claim (Ex. The technology used in World War 2 caused more tragic destruction than seen in any other conflict of the twentieth century.)

II. Man's Best

This section might contain a description as well as examples of how man's best was utilized throughout the conflict.

III. Man's Worst

This section might contain a description as well as examples of HOW man's best was used to accomplish terrible deeds.

IV. Effects

This section should describe any ongoing effects that are felt as a result of what you have already described.

V. Conclusion
