ORDINANCE NO. 2012 - 42

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE LOW AND BEST BID FOR THE NORTH EAST STREET STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM FORD DEVELOPMENT AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Mason received on June 7, 2012 a total of 7 competitive bids for construction of the North East Street Storm Sewer Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, tabulation and analysis of the bids received on June 7, 2012 indicates that the lowest and best bid was provided by Ford Development, in the total amount of \$67,895.75.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Mason, Ohio, seven members thereto concurring:

- <u>Section 1.</u> That the contract for the North East Street Storm Sewer Improvements Project is awarded to Ford Development at the bid amount of \$67,895.75.
- <u>Section 2.</u> That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute contract documents with Ford Development on behalf of the City of Mason.
- <u>Section 3.</u> That the Finance Director is authorized to make payment to Ford Development on the basis of approved payment applications, up to the contract amount of \$67,895.75.
- <u>Section 4.</u> That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health, safety, and general welfare and shall be effective immediately upon its passage. The reason for said declaration of emergency is the need to complete construction and improve drainage in the North East Street area at the earliest possible date.
