2015 RED BANK PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. No individual or unit will be allowed to participate in the parade without the prior approval of the City of Red Bank.
- 2. Mechanical equipment must be in sound working condition and must carry one or more portable emergency fire extinguishers.
- 3. Parade entry must be covered by adequate liability insurance.
- 4. Placement of the parade entries in the lineup is the responsibility of the City of Red Bank.
- 5. All individuals and organizations participating in the parade are subject to the laws and regulations of the City of Red Bank. Failure to adhere to those laws and regulations or to obey the lawful command of an official empowered to give such command, will be cause for immediate removal from the parade and may be cause for arrest and/or fine.
- 6. Security arrangements for the parade entries are the sole responsibility of the parade participant.
- 7. Parade officials assigned for that purpose will control the conduct and movement of the parade. Participants will obey the directions of the Parade Officials as they relate to the parade. Failure to do so will cause the offending individual or unit to be removed from the parade.
- 8. All units must be identified so spectators and officials can easily see the name of each unit or its sponsor. Identification on floats must be on both sides, running almost the entire length of the float. Marchers carrying banners or signs that can be easily read must precede marching units and others. All identification signs and banners must be carried and/or displayed in such a way as to assure they can be seen. Young children should not be assigned to carry identification banners.
- 9. All entries will lineup on Dayton Blvd. in a pre-assigned area unless prior authorization is received from City of Red Bank Parade Director.
- 10. Carpooling is encouraged to lineup location.
- 11. Units may contain no element higher than 13 feet, to provide clearance of overhead wires and traffic lights.
- 12. The parade will move at the rate of 120 adult steps (22 inches) to the minute (2.5 mph). No unit incapable of maintaining that pace for the duration of the parade will be included. Children age 5 and under must be carried or ride in a vehicle, wagon, trailer, etc.
- 13. Entries must be in their assigned lineup area at the designated time. Late arrivals will have a difficult time getting to the assigned location and may be ejected from parade lineup.
- 14. Equestrian entries must provide their own means of transporting trailers to the disbanding area. Equestrian entries are limited and are accepted on a first come basis. **Equestrian entries must wear equestrian diapers.**
- 15. NO CANDY OR OBJECTS OF ANY KIND CAN BE THROWN FROM THE PARADE VEHICLES OR FLOATS. ITEMS MAY BE HANDED TO THE CROWD AT CURBSIDE ONLY.
- 16. No fireworks or discharge of firearms are allowed. VIOLATORS WILL BE IMMEDIATELY EJECTED AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PARTICIPATE IN FUTURE PARADES.
- 17. Individuals and organizations in the parade are expected to perform courteously, in good taste, and with safety in mind at all times during the formation, execution, and dismissal of the parade. Officials will remove any person or unit that in their sole discretion violates this regulation.
- 18. DO NOT STOP AT ANY TIME DURING THE PARADE UNLESS YOU HAVE PRE-AUTHORIZED APPROVAL. This interrupts the pace of the parade and produces large gaps in the parade procession.
- 19. To avoid confusion please do not include a "Santa or Mrs. Claus" in your entry, he will be at the end of the parade.
