

#### YEAR ONE - TEACHING INTERN CERTIFICATE STEPS:

- 1. BEFORE APPLYING FOR INTERN CERTIFICATION
  - a. A passing score on one or more of the subject knowledge portion(s) of the Arizona Educator Proficiency Assessment (AEPA) OR a comparable subject knowledge examination from another state or a Master's degree in the appropriate subject area. If a subject knowledge proficiency assessment is not offered, an approved area shall consist of 24 semester hours of subject-related courses from an accredited institution. Note: An approved area in general science is comprised of 12 semester hours of life science and 12 semester hours of physical science courses. Submit a notarized copy of the original score report for out-of-state examinations at the time of application. The score report submitted must indicate "Pass" on it.
  - IVP Fingerprint card AZ Department of Public Safety (602-223-2279)
     NOTE: Effective January 1, 2008, per Arizona State Statute A.R.S. 15-106, an applicant who applies for a teaching certificate shall submit an Identity Verified Prints (IVP) Fingerprint card. "Non-IVP" Arizona fingerprint clearance card issued on or after January 1, 2008 will NOT be accepted.
  - c. Official university/college transcripts showing <u>degree conferred</u>; Bachelor's or above from an accredited school.
  - d. Official transcripts or Structured English Immersion Certificate of Training verifying 3 semester hours or 45 clock hours of state approved Structured English Immersion training for either the provisional or full SEI endorsement. For approved SEI coursework see:

- e. Letter of verification indicating the candidate is enrolled in an Arizona State Board approved alternative path to certification program or an Arizona State Board approved teacher preparation program.

#### YEAR TWO

- 1. Qualification for the initial issuance of the teaching intern certificate outlined in State Board of Education Rule R7-2-614 (E)(5).
- 2. Letter from university/college indicating required coursework is completed satisfactorily.
- 3. Official university/college transcripts documenting the completion of the required coursework
- 4. The submission of an <u>'Extension of Teacher Intern Certificate'</u> application. There is no fee to extend the certificate.
- 5. If you otherwise qualify for the certificate but are deficient in Arizona and/or U.S. Constitution you have 3 years under a valid teaching certificate to fulfill the requirement, except that if you are teaching an academic course on History, Government, Social Studies, Citizenship, Law, or Civics, you have 1 year to fulfill the requirement(s).

**Note:** It is recommended that the appropriate Professional Knowledge AEPA exam be passed, along with the AZ & US Constitution requirements, during the first semester of second year to ensure ample processing time for the provisional teaching certificate prior to expiration of teaching intern certification.

# APPLICATION FOR PROVISIONAL TEACHING CERTIFICATE

The holder of the teaching intern certificate may apply for an Arizona Provisional Teaching Certificate upon the completion of the following:

- 1. Submission of an Institutional Recommendation (IR) verifying the successful completion of an Arizona State Board authorized alternative path to certification program or an Arizona State Board approved teacher preparation.
- 2. A passing score on the required professional knowledge portion of the Arizona Teacher Proficiency Assessment (AEPA) or a comparable professional knowledge examination from another state.
- 3. Full Structured English Immersion (SEI) endorsement.
- 4. Arizona/US Constitution.
- 5. \$60 check, money order or cashier's check

The Teaching Intern certificate is valid for one year and may be extended yearly for no more than two consecutive years. The Teaching Intern certificate entitles the holder to enter into a teaching contract while completing the requirements for an Arizona Provisional Teaching certificate. During the valid period of the Teaching Intern certificate the holder may teach in a Structured English Immersion (SEI) classroom or in any subject area in which the holder has passed the appropriate Arizona Educator Proficiency Assessment (AEPA). The candidate shall be enrolled in an Arizona State Board authorized alternative path to certification program, or an Arizona State Board approved teacher preparation program. An individual is not eligible to hold the certificate more than once in a five-year period.

# **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION:**

Please submit the following:

- **A.** One of the following:
  - 1. A photocopy of your valid Arizona IVP fingerprint card (plastic) issued on or after January 1, 2008; or
  - 2. A photocopy of your valid Arizona fingerprint clearance card (plastic) issued prior to January 1, 2008.
  - B. A completed *Application for a Teaching Intern Certificate* and a money order, cashier's check or personal check ONLY for \$60, made payable to the Arizona Department of Education (ADE). Additional approved areas are \$60 each. Fees are <u>not</u> refundable. Cash will not be accepted. This application will be processed in the Phoenix office only.
  - C. Official transcripts documenting a Bachelor's or more advanced degree from an accredited institution.

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- D. A passing score on one or more of the subject knowledge portion(s) of the Arizona Educator Proficiency Assessment (AEPA) or a comparable subject knowledge examination from another state or a Master's degree in the appropriate subject area. Submit a notarized copy of the original score report for out-of-state examinations at the time of application. Master's degree must be verified by submitting official transcript(s).
- **E.** Official transcripts or Structured English Immersion (SEI) Certificate of Training verifying 3 semester hours or 45 clock hours of state approved SEI training for either the Provisional or Full SEI endorsement.
- **F.** Letter of verification indicating the candidate is enrolled in an Arizona State Board approved alternative path to certification program or an Arizona State Board approved teacher preparation program.

Through the College Cost Reduction and Access Act of 2007, Congress created the Teacher Education Assistance for College and Higher Education (TEACH) Grant Program that provides grants of up to \$4,000 per year to students who intend to teach in a public or private elementary or secondary school that serves students from low-income families. Recipients of this grant must teach for at least four academic years. (Note: TTT participants must teach in *public* schools that meet the definition of high-need and are operated by a high-need LEA for at least *three* years). Individuals interested in becoming teachers and who would like more information about the TEACH Grant Program should contact the financial aid office at the college where they will be enrolled starting with the 2008–2009 school year to find out if the college is participating in this program.
