GENERAL RULES FOR ALL CLASSES

1. All drivers must complete an entry application and attend the drivers meeting with pit crew the day of the derby.

2. Drivers 16 and 17 years of age are allowed to compete with a parental consent.

3. No driver substitutions are allowed, period.

4. Each driver and pit crew member will receive and must wear Pit ID Bands.

5. All drivers must wear an approved full-face helmet, eye protection and seat/safety belts.

6. Fire protective suit is recommended. FULL length pants & long sleeve shirts required. NO NYLON, cotton/ flannel is recommended.

7. Vehicles can be decorated in good taste ONLY. No foul words, slogans or artwork. This is a family atmosphere.

8. Poor sportsmanship or misconduct towards drivers, hosts or fans may result in disqualification and removal from the grounds.

9. Threats to another driver at anytime are grounds for disqualification and possible lifetime band. It is assault & will not be tolerated.

10. Top winners in each heat will run in the final. The remainder of cars from each heat will run in the Consolation/Semi Final Round. Black Flagged cars are done for the heat and may run in the conciliation heat if there is one. If the infraction is severe, you will be disqualified for the night.

11. Ellsworth Funsters , Pierce County Fair and Boyd Inc will not be responsible for injuries to anyone in the arena or pit areas.

12. Judges decisions are final. No complaints, period.

13. Arguing with a judge will result in disqualification and forfeiture of winnings.

Specific Demolition Derby Provisions.

1. All strip moldings, plastics and glass must be removed from the car prior to entering grounds including the glass from windshield. (No glass left inside the car. All headlights and taillights must be removed.)

2. All vehicles that do not pass the initial inspection will be allowed to make corrections. If the vehicle is not able to pass inspection within the allowed time it will not be allowed to run. No Refunds.

3. Cars can be inspected at any time and will be randomly inspected after the initial inspection.

4. All cars must have working brakes at start of inspection.

5. No teaming: Holding or pinning a car against another car or arena wall is not allowed. Both are grounds for disqualification.

6. No running of any car in to the barriers intentionally. Any car that intentionally runs another car in to the barriers will be disqualified. No hitting of cars that are within 5 feet of the barriers and are not in motion.

7. Any disqualification or black flag due to a rule infraction may result in banning from derby events for the following year. This will be determined do to the severity of the cause of the black flag.

8. Speed in the pit area must be kept to a minimum. IDLE!

9. Drivers are not allowed to leave the arena with their car during the heat.

10. All vehicles will receive a wooden lath stick after successful inspections.

11. Break your stick to be eliminated from the competition while in the arena.

12. All drivers have a set time (60 seconds) to make a hit. Drivers failing to make a hit will be out of the compotation and will be told to break off their stick by judges or flagmen.

13. Intentional driver door hits are not allowed and will result in disqualification for the remainder of the night.

14. If a vehicle is rolled, the event will stop, the vehicle up-righted, and it will be allowed to continue provided the vehicle is considered safe.

15. Two (2) fires in any car in any one heat will disqualify that car, or as the Ellsworth Fire Department deems necessary.

16. No starting fluid can be used in any car during any heat.

17. Protest fee of \$200 must be prior to running. Must talk to Chad Boyd only.

18. Stock gas tank must be removed. A small metal gas tank must be mounted in the rear seat area. The tank must be very secure and covered. It must be properly fastened secure to floor with bolts and covered. No seat belting of the tank allowed. The fuel-line must be run through passenger's compartment. Absolutely NO plastic gas cans. The can MUST be capped and sealed. 19. All vehicles must have any front and rear bumpers.

20. Protruding objects are not allowed on the vehicle. We do not want people getting injured!

21. Electric fuel pump allowed, however ON/OFF switch must be clearly marked.

22. Floor shifts are allowed. Ignition and wiring modifications (hotwire) allowed.

23. Hood must have 12"X12" minimum opening for easy access to extinguish fires. Extra hole(s) in hood are not required if header holes are at least 12"X12".

2015 Pierce County WI Fair Demolition Derby Mini Class Rules

1. Refer to general rules for non building rules. This class is open to any small truck, mini van, or suv.

2. AWD and 4WD are not allowed

3. Motor swaps allowed. Only 4 and 6 cylinders allowed. Motor mounts may be welded or chained but not to strengthen the frame in any way.

4. No tires bigger than 16". No split rims. Paddle tires, double tires and valve stem protectors are allowed.

5. Original gas tank must be removed. You must use a maximum 6 gallon boat tank or well made fuel cell and must be securely fastened and covered. NO Plastic Tanks.

6. Electronic fuel pump may be used but must be clearly marked on and off. Use properly rated fuel lines and "NO" fuel lines are to be ran under the vehicle.

7. Gas tank protectors allowed.

8. All trailer hitches and bracing must be removed.

9. Battery must be secured in front passenger floor area and must be covered with a non-conductive material. Stock ignition or push button/toggle switch may be used.

10. You may run a dash bar, back bar, passenger and driver door bar. Can have 4 down bars but may not attach to the frame. You must use a minimum of 6" plate and max of 12" plate on back and dash bar, so it doesn't act as a spear. All cage bars must be no larger than 6", except for pass door support bar which as stated is 2" maximum.

11. Any automobile type bumper may be used. (Excluding homemade and Chrysler V bumpers). You may weld bumper brackets to frame. 3 x 3 square x6" long square tubing may be stuffed into frame and bolted or welded. Bumper seams may be welded, but no added metal and may not be stuffed. No capped ends on bumpers

12. Rear bumper may be chained or welded to the body or frame, but not both.

13. Hood must open for inspection, hood may be secured by six bolts no larger than 1" two may go through the frame, must have a hole big enough to get inspectors head inside. Hole must be large enough for inspection, and to get fire extinguisher inside for fire control, or you will have to cut.

14. Doors and tailgates may be chained, wired, or welded shut. If welded, you can weld 5" on and 5" off with $2^{"}x5^{"}x 1/8$ " thick patches or smaller. If chained or wired, may use on two spots per door seam. Drivers door may be welded shut and may also have a plate on outside but may not run more than 6" past the front and rear part of door seam.

15. Radiator barrels may be used. If stock radiator is used, may use a radiator protector. Radiator barrels can be welded in 4 spots but not to frame.

16. Transmission coolers allowed but must be secured and covered. Shifters may be modified.

17. Brake pedal and gas pedal aftermarket parts may used but may not attach to the frame or be used for structural support.

18. No Wedging or body creasing

*** This is a trial run for a new class so use common sense, any overkill of the rules or "grey areas" will result in automatic loading with no refunds or chances to cut.
