We propose to replace the courses PHYS 220V Introduction to Electronics I and PHYS 320V Introduction to Electronics II by a new course PHYS 3213 Electronics in Experimental Physics. The contents of the old courses have become dated due to rapid advances in this field, and a new course is warrented to update the course contents. The old courses were based on Radio Shack textbooks from the 1970's, so are now archaic. This change will affect the BA Physics program course requirements as well as the BS Physics program requirements for some concentrations.
