Story Structure:

Identify the structure of the story: beginning, middle, and end. Be able to identify key characters, setting, problems, and solutions.

Story Purpose:

Talk about why the author may have written this story. What do you think the author is trying to teach us?

Sing a Song:

Create a song about the story of *Charlotte's Web*.

Alternate Ending:

Create an alternate ending the novel, different than the one the author wrote. Get creative, but make sure the ending makes sense!

Mask Making:

Make a mask of any character in the novel. Be anything from a pig to a spider.
