## **Requirements:**

- Must be a currently registered Savannah State University
- Must use the equipment to complete Journalism & Mass Communications course assignments.
- Must be in good standing with the University.
- Must have a current SSU ID Card.

## **Conditions of Use:**

- Only **one camera and tripod** per person may be checked out at a time. JMC equipment is available on a first-come first-serve basis. Students may sign up on waiting list when all unavailable.
- Checkout and Return times are only available between the hours 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday
- Must be responsible for the safe and timely return of the borrowed JMC.
- The borrower who signed the Loan Agreement <u>must be</u> the one to return the borrowed equipment.
- JMC borrowing privileges will be suspended for the remainder of the academic year if the borrowed JMC is not returned on time.
- JMC equipment returned late will be assessed the following late fees, plus an additional \$5 a day for every day it is late:
  - Digital Camera: \$100
  - Tablets: \$50
- Personal software may not be loaded onto the equipment.
- JMC students are responsible for providing batteries and SD storage cards for each device.
- Anything saved on a device will be erased.
- Borrower must abide by all university, state and federal policies and laws regarding the appropriate use of university network and computing resources.
- Any inappropriate material will be reported to the chair.

- When JMC equipment is issued, annotate any damage on the form and ensure that the JMC equipment is functioning properly.
- If equipment is stolen, notify the SSU Campus Police and the JMC Loaner Program staff so that a police/security report may be completed.
- **DO NOT** loan JMC equipment anyone else.
- SSU reserves the right to freeze the asset.

Student accepts full responsibility for the JMC equipment during loaner period. Student will reimburse Savannah State University for the cost of repairing or replacing this equipment if it is damaged, lost, stolen or not returned while on loan. Student understands that the replacement cost for this JMC equipment will be the actual cost associated with replacing it at current prices for the same model (or similar if same model is not available)
