Summer 2015

\$145 - By September 18 (Deadline to participate in Fall Commencement)

\$175 - September 19 - October 30

\$300 - After October 30

Spring 2016

\$145 - By December 4

\$175 - December 5 - January 29

\$300 - After January 29 (Applying after this date may prevent participation in commencement related activities.)

HONORS

Undergraduate students will receive honors at graduation for work completed through their Fall semester, however the student's permanent record will reflect the overall GPA through the final semester. Latin honors are determined on the basis of the cumulative grade point average (GPA) of all coursework completed at Concordia University and all other colleges and universities attended. Students who also complete the requisite number of Honors courses will receive recognition at graduation as Honors Associate or Honors Scholar. All students who qualify for honors will be invited to the Academic Achievement Service on Friday, May 6, 2016 by the Office of the Provost.

REGALIA - \$55 + Postage and Handling

Graduates will be responsible for ordering and paying for their own regalia (cap, gown, hood and tassel). Graduates will be informed via email when to order regalia.

Exit Loan Counseling
