The College recognizes the important role that Fraternity and Sorority Life plays in a student's co-curricular experience. The Fraternity and Sorority Life awards process provides a means whereby the men's and women's fraternities of Monmouth College may measure their activities and programs against the founding principles of fraternal organizations. It provides a means of ensuring that the actions of men's and women's fraternities are congruent with the values articulated in their rituals and creeds.
