Individual study is available for one to five credit hours with the determination of hours subject to approval by the faculty sponsor. All such credit is graded Satisfactory (S) or Unsatisfactory (U) and will not affect a student's cumulative point-hour ratio. A maximum of 15 hours of individual study credit may be applied toward a degree. Please note, only four Individual Study credit hours will count toward the required social work electives.

It is the responsibility of the faculty sponsor and student to structure, design and implement a course of study. A student should initiate this process with a written proposal in accordance with the guidelines indicated on this form. This project should be designed in accordance with the academic standards of the College and University. All requests must have the approval of the faculty sponsor and the Undergraduate Program Director.
