**Eligibility: All Undergraduate EN Majors (Options I and II) working toward a first degree and also majoring/minoring in History**

One-year scholarship. Prior-year recipients may apply.

Applications received in the UNA Department of English by the first Monday in February are considered for the academic year's award, which begins fall semester.
