

2005 UCCE PISTACHIO PRODUCTION SHORT COURSE MATERIALS ORDER FORM

The 2005 UCCE Pistachio Production Short Course was held November 8 – 10, 2005 in Fresno, California. The course materials were designed to deliver the latest research-based production practices in a format that enabled prospective or current pistachio growers, production managers, and pest control consultants to better achieve their pistachio growing goals. Speakers covered the following topics:

- economics of establishment and production
- orchard site selection and development
- an assessment of the current cultivars and rootstocks
- irrigation
- fertilization
- training and pruning
- weeds
- pest and disease diagnosis and control
- postharvest handling

The set of course materials includes:

- A 256-page manual covering the topics listed above, plus 38 pages of color plates.
- A searchable CD of the manual with links to two interactive Excel calculators: Sample Costs to Produce Pistachios in the San Joaquin Valley 2004 (low-volume irrigation); Calculating Leaching Depth to Achieve Desired Salinity for Soil Reclamation.
- A Nutrition, Insect, and Disease Identification Guide with 164 color plates.
