ABSTRACT GUIDELINES:

- 1. Use the official abstract form.
- 2. Indicate preference for paper or poster presentation or either on the abstract form.
- 3. Type the abstract on the official form and do not exceed ONE PAGE.
- 4. Abstracts will be evaluated based on the quality of the following areas.

Please use the headings that FIT your type of project

- A. Problem statement
- B. Purpose and/or hypothesis and/or objectives
- C. Theoretical/conceptual framework (where applicable)
- D. Methods (for quantitative research describe design, sample/sampling, instruments, procedure, analysis; for qualitative research and CQI/clinical or educational evaluation projects describe the methodology/procedure)
- E. Final or preliminary results
- F. Interpretations, conclusions, implications for nursing

POSTER GUIDELINES:

- 1. All posters will be displayed on the walls of the UCLA School of Nursing on Tuesday and Wednesday (May 10-11, 2011).
- 2. The poster should be readable from 4 feet away.
- 3. MAXIMUM poster size if 4feet high and 8feet long (smaller posters are OK, as long as they can be read from 4 feet away).
