What is Federal Work-Study?

The Federal Work-Study Program provides funding for students with financial need, allowing them to earn money to help pay education expenses. Work-study jobs can be on-campus or off-campus. If you work off campus, your employer must be a private nonprofit organization or a government agency, and the work performed must be in the public interest. The Federal Work-Study Program is a matching funds program, which means your employer must be able to pay a percentage of your total earnings (currently set at 40% of total earnings in 2013-14).

To apply for Federal Work-Study at Hastings College of the Law students must submit:

- 1. Financial Aid Supplement
- 2. Federal Work-Study Application
- 3. 2013-2014 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or Renewal FAFSA

To receive consideration for Federal Work-Study, Hastings College Grants, or Federal Perkins Loans the Supplement and the FAFSA must be submitted or postmarked on or before **February 15, 2013**. Applications submitted after this deadline will receive the best financial aid package available depending on remaining funds.
