1. Letter of Recommendation

A letter of recommendation from someone who knows you and is familiar with your academic work, such as a TA, faculty member, your campus EAP faculty director, an employer, or the head of a nonprofit where you have volunteered. You may use a letter that was solicited for your general EAP application. **Personal references are not acceptable.** A letter of recommendation is required for all scholarships. You may submit additional letters, but they are not required.

2. Statement of Purpose

A clear, concise statement (800-1000 words) addressing the following topics:

- Brief description of UCEAP study abroad experience, including location and school/program. Include why you chose to study abroad, and this program in particular, and how it has influenced your educational experience and future career prospects.
- Brief description of why you wish to become a UCEAP Student Ambassador.
- Brief description of how you would promote UCEAP programs on your campus. Please be as specific and creative as possible.
- If applying for a leadership position, please indicate which position (President, Vice-President, Secretary) and describe why you would be an ideal candidate. Include any previous leadership experience.

3. Transcript

Submit a copy of your unofficial transcript that shows grades through your last completed term. Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA required.
