Requirements for Form and Carpenter's Bracket Scaffolds


Environmental Health and Safety

General Requirements

All form and carpenter's bracket scaffolds shall be constructed in accordance with the general, platform and guardrail requirements for fabricated frame scaffolds – "**Requirements for Fabricated Frame Scaffolds**".

Specific Requirements

- All brackets, except those for wooden bracket scaffolds, shall be attached to the supporting formwork or structure by means of one or more of the following:
 - Welding;
 - Hooking over a secured structural supporting member;
 - Nails;
 - A metal stud attachment device, with the form wales either bolted to the form or secured by snap ties or tie bolts extending through the form and securely anchored; or
 - For carpenters bracket scaffolds only, by a bolt extending through to the opposite side of the structure's wall;
- Wooden bracket-form scaffolds shall be an integral part of the form panel; and
- Folding type metal brackets, when extended for use, shall be either bolted or secured with a locking-type pin.
