WHAT IS THE ROTARY CLUB OF APPLE VALLEY TEACHERS' MINI-GRANTS PROGRAM?

The Rotary Club of Apple Valley Teachers' Mini-Grants Program awards limited number of grants ranging up to \$500 for special classroom projects to individual teachers of kindergarten through the twelfth grades in the Apple Valley Unified School District. The minigrants provide funds to innovative teachers who want to develop new ideas to enrich the student classroom experience. The mini-grants are awarded to teachers who would not otherwise have sources of funding or who would have to use their own money to support the project.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any kindergarten through twelfth grade classroom teacher in the Apple Valley School District is encouraged to apply for a mini-grant.

HOW ARE AWARDS MADE?

A panel of Rotary representatives from education and business will review all applications, evaluating for innovation, benefit to students and clarity.

Grant awards will provide funds for materials, equipment and other resources necessary to carry out a proposed project. Specialized educational trips will be considered only if they are an integral part of a proposed innovative activity.

A ceremony for awarding the mini-grants will be held at a Rotary Club of Apple Valley meeting or at one of the schools.

HOW IS EVALUATION DONE?

Teachers complete the application form and submit it as indicated. Mini-grant recipients may be expected to complete brief written evaluations and budget expenditure reports upon project completion.
