REPORTS - POLICE DEPARTMENT

Police Chief Ron Gilbert reported that the department traveled 6114 miles during June; responded to 624 non-dispatched calls; 123 dispatched calls; 16 officers assists, and assisted the fire department 3 times. Besides all of this, 216 citations, 22 warnings and 141 warrants were issued (cleared 78 warrants) worked 52 cases, 46 misdemeanor arrests and 5 felony arrests were made. Reserve Officer Tammie Heeth was named Officer of the Month.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Fire Chief Jay Stutts reported that the Fire Department responded to 42 calls for assistance during June. 30 medical calls, 1 structure fire, 2 grass fires, 1 vehicle fire, 4 motor vehicle accidents, 2 lake rescues, 0 landing zones, 1 assist call and 1 mutual aide call, totaling 63 volunteer man hours.

BUILDING DEPARTMENT

Building Inspector Roy Newport reported that during June, 16 permits were issued which increased the Value by \$176,400. Year-to-date Total: \$999,280.

CITY PARK

Roy Newport reported that Lowe's has ordered their donation for the park will take several weeks to get it in. Also, we had some park equipment donated and can use volunteers to help get it installed.
