NO debris from LARGE remodeling jobs, but small quantities of roofing tear-off and concrete will be accepted. (The intent is for small chunks of concrete, such as concrete used for fence posts.) *No paint or hazardous household waste*, such as pesticides and cleaning agents, will be accepted but empty and dry paint cans are OK.

Metal will be accepted and sold for recycling with the proceeds going to the MVNA treasury! **Yard debris and tree cuttings** will be accepted.

Please separate refuse, metal, and yard debris to make unloading easier at the different dumpsters.

We will accept electronics: TVs, VCRs, computer CPUs, laptops, monitors, disk drives, power cords, cables, and game consoles as they are all accepted by Goodwill Industries, where you can take them every day.
