

Kīpuka Native Hawaiian Student Center – COMPUTER USE AGREEMENT

Kīpuka Native Hawaiian Student Center provides UH Hilo students, faculty, and staff; access to computers and technological resources to enhance its educational, social, and cultural missions in service to it's many constituencies. The primary function of the computers and technology resources at Kīpuka is to support college success. Thus the security and maintenance of these limited resources are paramount. This COMPUTER USE AGREEMENT for all computers and technology resources at Kīpuka is based on common courtesy and respect for the facilities, equipment and personnel. Use of these resources is a privilege and assumes responsible, ethical, and legal conduct by the user.

All users should read this information before they use the computers and technology resources. Use of the computers and technology resources is subject to all college policies and all local, state, and federal laws including but not limited to the guidelines listed below.

- 1. There will be no food or drink consumption while using computers.
- 2. Users are to run or access only those programs that are preloaded onto computers.
- 3. Users are not to submit, publish, view, or display on the network any defamatory, abusive, obscene, profane, sexually oriented, or illegal material. This includes the illegal download and/or viewing of pirated movies.
- 4. Users are responsible for any charges, surcharges, or fees incurred while accessing the network.
- 5. Users are not to intentionally harm data, software, or equipment that is part of the Kīpuka / college network. Users are not to harm data or equipment belonging to another user. Users are held liable for any such software or equipment damaged.
- 6. Users will not permit any other person to posses or use the computer they borrowed.

Violation of any of the above guidelines may result in disciplinary action by the appropriate administrator and suspension or termination of the user's computer privileges. Any damages, theft and/or software problems that affect a computer in your possession, through negligence or otherwise, with be your responsibility. Any use of computing resources for any illegal purpose
