The Annual City of Folly Beach Christmas Parade is a unique opportunity to participate in a community holiday event, as citizens, visitors and locals line up along Center Street while the floats, marching bands and community associations show their holiday spirit. There is *no* fee, but registration is **required**.

Floats, walking groups and other entries are encouraged to be creative, imaginative and fun in their design and theme and that you stay within the *holiday spirit*. Throwing any items, beads, candy or other giveaways and consuming alcoholic beverages while operating floats in parade is **strictly forbidden**. Items can be handed out by people walking only in the parade.

New Parade Route! This year, the parade begins at West Ashley and 2nd street and will be staged along West Arctic. The route will head north on Center Street and end at the River City Park. From there, floats can leave the island directly over the Folly River Bridge or teardown in the boat landing. Staging begins at 11 a.m. The parade begins at 1 p.m., sharp.

Entries accepted on a first come, first serve basis and space is limited.

City of Folly Beach Parade Rules and Liability Waiver

There is only one Santa, and he rides on a fire truck at the end of the parade! It is confusing to small children to see more than one Santa riding on floats; therefore no one may dress as Santa on your float or in your vehicle.

The following guidelines help ensure the quality and safety of the parade and allow as many organizations as possible the opportunity to participate. Read carefully and abide by the rules!

1. Each entrant is allowed a **maximum of three units** per rule on page 2.
2. All entries, including golf carts and cars, **must be decorated** in the spirit of the event.
3. There will only be **one Santa** in the parade at the end on the fire truck.
4. Entrants must display lineup number on the front and organization name on each side of entry.
5. All entries must stage on West Arctic, near the starting point at West Ashley and 2nd.
6. **NO ITEMS ARE TO BE THROWN FROM VEHICLES AT ANY TIME.** Giveaways must be handed out by walkers. No choking hazard items can be handed out.
7. Riders on floats cannot get on and off of the float during the parade at any time. No drinking on floats.
8. All entries with children must have adults riding/walking with them throughout the entire event.
9. Walkers alongside vehicles must walk at least 10 feet from the side of vehicle.
10. Use of fire or open flames is not allowed.
11. Any firearms, real or replicas, must get approval in advance.
12. ALL wheels of motorized vehicles **MUST** keep in contact with the ground at all times. Anyone doing wheelies will be pulled from the parade immediately.
13. Each motorized vehicle must carry liability insurance and be operated by a licensed driver.
14. No one will be allowed to ride on the hood or roof of any vehicle.
15. No political campaigning is allowed on entries in the parade.
16. The undersigned agrees that all participants may be photographed or videotaped and these images may be published in an outlet used to promote or publicize the event.

Entries must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow all instructions from Police and parade officials. The City of Folly Beach reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade, at its discretion.

LIABILITY WAIVER: In consideration of your accepting my entry, I hereby, for myself, my child and all participants of my entry, my heirs, executors and administrators, waive and release any and all rights and claims for damages I, my child, or entry participants may have against the City of Folly Beach and its representatives, successors and assigns for any and all injuries suffered by myself or my child or entry participants at any activity sponsored by these groups. I have read in its entirety the general rules and the entry guidelines for participating in the City of Folly Beach Christmas Parade and agree to accept full responsibility for the compliance of this entry and all participants associated therewith, and for any liability inherent with this entry's participation in the City of Folly Beach Christmas Parade. I understand that if I fail to comply with all the guidelines and rules for participation that my entry will be removed from the parade lineup.
