## Western Minnesota Regional Science Fair Saturday, March 1, 2014 Paper Registration Form for Grades 7-12

The Western Minnesota Regional Research Paper Competition is open to all students in Grades 6-12 who have done either experimental or library research. Each student researches a topic of interest to him/or her and writes about that research.

## **TYPES OF RESEARCH PAPERS:**

- a. An **INVESTIGATIVE** RESEARCH PAPER is the report of an actual experiment that the student has performed. Many students write a research paper on their science project.
- b. A **LIBRARY** RESEARCH PAPER is a report on other people's work documented by library sources. It is expected the paper involves some kind of research into an area where there is question and evidence is waged scientifically. It is not to be a paper that simply describes a particular topic. Where there is controversy, the student should take a stand, which he or she supports based upon the information available, from the library references.

The judging process for research papers in this Region involves judging prior to the fair.

- 1. Each entrant must send in:
  - a. Two (2) typewritten copies of the paper. (Be sure the student keeps a copy).
  - b. One (1) registration form.
  - c. A check or money order for \$10 made out to Western Minnesota Regional Science Fair, (non-refundable.)
- 2. Papers must be stapled—NO BINDERS.
- 3. Each paper must have a **Title Page** containing the following information:
  - a. Title of the paper (Please keep it short—one line.)
  - b. The student's name
  - c. School
  - d. Grade and age
  - e. Category of research (See the abstract form)
  - f. Type of paper—investigative (experimental) or library research.
  - g. Advisor's name
- 4. Paper length is limited to no more than 8 pages of text, double-spaced, 12 characters per inch or larger with one inch margins minimum. This excludes the title page, abstract, bibliography, and appendices.
- 5. The abstract should come directly after the title page.
- 6. Any paper not following these rules will not get beyond the first round of judging.
- 7. INVESTIGATIVE PAPERS MUST STAY WITHIN ISEF AND REGIONAL FAIR RULES!

- 8. Judging:
  - a. Papers will be evaluated to determine if the student needs more basic work. Poor spelling, format, grammar, and bibliography are common problems.
  - b. The best papers will be chosen to compete at the Minnesota State Science Fair. These papers will be announced at the award ceremony at the Regional Science Fair on Feb. 11, 2012. Papers entered in the State Fair will require oral presentations.
  - c. Other paper awards will also be given at this time, and all papers will be returned only if obtained immediately after the fair. The regional fair director will not mail papers out to participants.
- 9. Please submit papers as soon as possible. PAPERS RECEIVED AFTER the **deadline of February 17, 2014**, WILL **NOT** BE JUDGED. DO NOT SEND BY THIRD CLASS MAIL!

  - c. Check or money order made out to WMR Science Fair for \$10 per paper (non-refundable).

- 4. Remember—papers are limited to 8 pages of text, double-spaced, 12 characters per inch or larger, one-inch margins excluding the title page, abstract, bibliography and appendices. The paper must be stapled.
