You can provide a copy of a court's decision that you were an emancipated minor immediately before you reached the age of being an adult in your state.</p> <p>Note: The United States Department of Education does not recognize Emancipation of a Mississippi Resident as being valid to establish independent student status for Federal Financial Aid.</p> <p>Documentation: Attach a copy of a court's decision of your emancipated minor status.</p>
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p>I am or I was in legal guardianship. Check this box only if:</p> <p>A. You can provide a copy of a court's decision that you are in legal guardianship, or</p> <p>B. You can provide a copy of a court's decision that you were in legal guardianship immediately before you reached the age of being an adult in your state.</p> <p>Note: For (A) and (B), the court must be located in your state of legal residence at the time the court's decision was issued.</p> <p>Documentation: If (A) above applies to you, attach a copy of the Letters of Guardianship. If (B) above applies to you, attach a copy of the court's Order of Discharge from Guardianship.</p>
