

REQUIREMENTS FOR 17 OR 18 YEAR OLD ELECTION JUDGES

- 1.) MUST BE 17 OR 18 YEARS OF AGE AND A JUNIOR OR A SENIOR IN PUBLIC OR PRIVATE SECONDARY SCHOOL. MUST BE IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE SCHOOL.**
- 2.) MUST HAVE A CUMULATIVE GRADE POINT AVERAGE EQUIVALENT TO AT LEAST A 3.0 OUT OF A 4.0 SCALE.**
- 3.) MUST HAVE WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM THE PRINCIPAL OF THE SCHOOL THEY ATTEND.**
- 4.) MUST HAVE WRITTEN PERMISSION FROM PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIAN.**
- 5. MUST COMPLETE ELECTION JUDGE TRAINING.**
- 6.) MUST DECLARE REPUBLICAN OR DEMOCRAT.**
- 7.) MUST BE UNITED STATES CITIZEN.**
- 8.) STUDENTS APPOINTED TO SERVE AS ELECTION JUDGES SHALL NOT BE COUNTED AS ABSENT ELECTION DAY.**
