I. Calculate your current University of Missouri Grade-Point Average:

The GPA is calculated by dividing the total number of UM semester hours of attempted coursework into the net total of grade points earned in those courses. This information can be found on your transcript. Each letter grade is assigned a numerical value (called a grade point) as follows:
