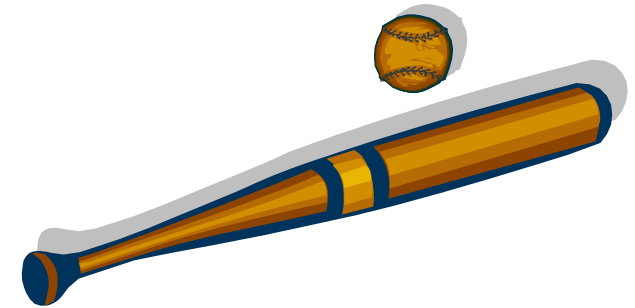

Tripp Keister/ Camp Director

Tripp Keister is starting his fourth year as the Head Baseball Coach at Wesley College. In 2008, Wesley Baseball was in postseason play for the second straight year with and had an overall record of 27-15. In 2007 Wesley finished 30-14 and set the school record for wins as he guided the team to postseason play for the first time since 1999. In three years at Wesley College he has won 80 games. In 2006, Coach Keister was named PAC Coach of the Year as he guided Wesley to their first winning season in five years. As a former scout with the San Diego Padres, Tripp signed four players to professional contracts including 2003 first round draft pick and current major league pitcher Tim Stauffer.

Tripp was the Head Coach at Delaware State University in 1999-2000 after a two year stint at the University of South Carolina as an assistant coach. During his coaching tenure, he has coached over 20 players that have gone on to play professional baseball, including current Houston Astros shortstop Adam Everett.

Tripp was a three-time first team all conference outfielder at the University of Delaware where he was drafted by the New York Mets in the 1992 Major League Draft.

Bret Underwood/Camp Coordinator

Bret Underwood is starting his fourth season as an assistant baseball coach at Wesley College where he works with hitters and infielders. Bret was a four year starter at Delaware State University where he was one of the most prolific hitters in school history. He ranks in the top three in hits, HR, RBI, runs, and extra base hits. After completing his senior year at Delaware State, Bret signed a free agent contract with the Boston Red Sox. Bret attended Dickinson High School in Wilmington, DE where he was a two time All-State selection.
