Dear parents, learners, colleagues and staff members of the DSJ

I would like to take this opportunity to wish all members of our school community a happy New Year. I hope that 2016 will again see constructive and successful cooperation, to the benefit of our school and the children in our care.

Even though we have just started the school year, we have already had numerous events. From 11th to 13th of January 2016, the teachers have had three days of preparation in which they attended many workshops and conferences. The new learners of the English Medium High School were traditionally welcomed by having a braai. On the first official school day, various assemblies took place. On the Friday, the Board of Directors invited all staff members to their annual *Vorstandsbraai*, whilst the new prefects

went away on a camp for the weekend.

The second week of January saw the start of the new grade 1 learners, which was followed by various parent information evenings from the Regentröpfchen right through to the secondary school. Let's see if we can keep this pace up until December!

During the holidays we had wonderful news: the official matric results were published. Our learners once again achieved excellent results, contrary to the countrywide trend. The 46 Matriculants achieved a 100% pass rate and are thus 30% above the country's average and 2% above the IEB's average. 98% achieved a qualification level to be allowed to study for a bachelor's degree, and with this we are 13% above the IEB's average of the private schools. This proves the excellent academic work at our school, both from the teachers as well as the learners. A sincere thank you from me to both teachers and learners for all their hard effort! The most successful learners were Leo Karamanhof and Jessica Hiestermann, who both passed with distinctions.

At the end of January, two of our staff members, Katrien Niemandt Schöttler in Marketing and our General Manager, Jobst Schulte -Brader will be leaving the school. I would like to thank both of them on behalf of the school community for the hard work they put in at the DSJ. We wish them all the very best for their personal and professional future.

In closing I would like to mention that on a regular basis we are still receiving complaints about rude and reckless drivers in our school parking lot; people driving too fast, parking in the wrong areas and are rude to our staff. I would like to ask all of you to be more considerate and keep to the rules that have been put into place. Thank you!
