What is CMR?

- □ Business process to collect information on Contracted efforts
- □ Applies to service contracts, including Architect-Engineer
- ☐ Contractors report data such as:
 - Location where work was performed
 - ✓ Direct labor dollars
 - ✓ Direct labor hours



When do I report CMR?

- □ By 31 October following the fiscal year (FY) the service was performed
- ☐ Current Fiscal Year (FY10):
 - √ 1 October 2009 thru 30 September 2010
- ☐ FY10 reporting by 31 October 2010
- ☐ Recommend reporting immediately following completion of work
