HOMEWORK

Homework is due the next class period. Homework turned in without work shown will not be accepted, it may be turned in the following class period with work as a late grade. Assignment sheets will be given at the beginning of each testing unit. It will include the dates, topics and homework assignment for each day and the date of the unit test. Assignment sheets are also posted on my web page accessible through the BISD website, www.boerne-isd.net.

QUIZZES, TESTS, & PROJECTS

All scheduled tests are printed on the unit assignment sheet. Approximately 3 tests will be given in each 9 week grading period. Quizzes will be given regularly throughout a unit.

- 1. No test corrections will be used to raise a test grade
- Failures will schedule a reteach and then a retest for a time other than the class period. <u>Retests are taken during tutorials</u>. Retests must be completed within a week of the original test date. The maximum grade for a retest is 70%.
- 3. No corrections or retakes will be given for quizzes.

LATE WORK

Late work will be accepted the following class meeting only and should be turned in to the **LATE** wall folder with the word "**LATE**" written on the assignment. A student will receive no more than a maximum of 70% on a late assignment. Homework that is turned in two or more days late is unacceptable. Students are allowed 2 late assignments per 9 weeks. 2 "LATE" passes will be given each 9 weeks.

ABSENCES/MAKE-UP WORK

If a student is absent it is his/her own responsibility to obtain any work missed <u>AND</u> to turn in work that was due the day the absence occurred. Make-up homework assignments will be placed in the absent box per class subject with your name on it. When turning in absent work (*work that was due the day the absence occurred*) or make-up work (*work assigned the day the absence occurred*) please write "ABSENT" on the assignment and place in the ABSENT wall folder. One class period is allowed for completion of the <u>Homework</u> for each day missed. One week is allowed for completion of <u>Quizzes</u> and <u>Tests</u>. Make-ups for quizzes and tests will be given in my room during tutoring hours. It is the students' responsibility to make arrangements to come before school or during activity period to complete the missing work. IF YOU ARE ABSENT ON A REVIEW DAY (the class before a test and no new material was presented) YOU ARE EXPECTED TO TAKE THAT TEST.

CHEATING

Cheating on any assignment, quiz, or test will result in a zero, a call home, and a discipline referral.

TUTORIALS

If you are beginning to have problems understanding the class work, please see me to arrange tutoring. I am available Tuesday and Thursday mornings starting at 8:05 to 8:35 and during activity period (activity tutorial passes will be given upon request). You are welcome to come to ask questions, or just to work on your assignment.

HALLWAY PASSES

2 Hallway passes will be given to each student at the beginning of each 9 weeks. These passes are for any reason you might need to leave the classroom i.e. going to the bathroom, forgot homework in locker or going to the library. Students will use the classroom plastic hall pass to sign IN/OUT after giving your hallway pass to the teacher.
