Lean Construction challenges all project stakeholders to develop and apply better ways to manage the overall construction process. *Unit 4: The Last Planner*[®] *System* is a half-day course that delves in creating six-week look-ahead schedules and weekly work plans.

Within construction, we all strive to plan our projects in a way that produces predictable workflow and continuous improvement. *Unit 4* is the second of two units introducing the Last Planner System (LPS). This half-day, facilitator-led course shows how to conduct make-ready and weekly work planning sessions. Following this course, participants will be able to:

- Apply the methods and tools utilized in pull planning
- Describe the concept of Lean Workstructuring
- Outline the desired products of Lean Workstructuring
- Describe the characteristics and application of the Last Planner[®] System
