ADN and LVN to RN PROGRAM APPLICATION CHECKLIST:

Before submitting your application PLEASE read the application directions and eligibility criteria requirements carefully. You must submit **ALL** application materials **TOGETHER** and **IN PERSON**. Use this checklist to make certain that your application is smoothly processed:

- Application must be neat, complete, accurate, and signed. The application must be submitted with <u>ALL</u> supporting documents present, including such items as transcripts, TEAS results, and any other required paperwork that applies to your application.
- Official Transcripts All official transcripts, including those from MiraCosta, must be submitted to verify completion of prerequisites and to calculate overall GPA.
- TEAS results Your first unofficial TEAS score must be submitted as well as your most current result (if applicable).
- Copy of current Vocational Nursing License All LVN to RN applicants must send a copy of their current California license. This is not needed for the ADN application.
- **Proof of 6 months work experience as an LVN for LVN-RN applicants ONLY.**

<u>The following documents need to be submitted if you wish to have points awarded</u> (if applicable)

- **Copy of CNA license**
- **Proof of recent Health care work or Volunteer experience**
- **Proof of documented disability**
- **Proof of eligibility for Financial Aid, Cal works, BOGFW-B, Federal Pell grant, etc.**
- **Verification of employment during the prerequisite course work from employer**
- **Verification you are an EOPS student**

- 1. <u>Eligibility Requirements for the RN Program</u>: <u>ALL</u> of the following must be met in order to <u>APPLY</u> to the RN Associate Degree in Nursing Program.
 - A. Overall cumulative grade point average (G.P.A.) of 2.5 for ALL college coursework.
 - B. Completion of the following SCIENCE PREREQUISITES with a combined G.P.A. of 2.5 with no grade less than "C" for each course and no more than one repetition for a substandard grade or withdrawal in any one of the 3 courses:
 - 1. Human Anatomy (BIO 210) 4 semester units or equivalent
 - 2. Human Physiology (BIO 220) 4 semester units or equivalent
 - 3. Microbiology (BIO 230) 4 5 semester units or equivalent

Note: Physiology and Microbiology must be completed within 7 years and Anatomy must be completed within 10 years of qualifying date of eligibility.

- C. Completion of the following PREREQUISITES with a grade of no less than "C":
 - 1. Composition and Reading (ENGL 100) 4 semester units or equivalent
 - 2. Intermediate Algebra (Math 64) 4 semester units or equivalent (or a passing score on the Math Placement Test)

Note: Sociology/Psychology and Communication/Speech must be completed to receive points in the "Fixed Set" GPA section.

E. <u>Testing Requirement:</u> All RN students must pass the Test of Essential Academic Skills (TEAS) 5.0. This is a diagnostic test that covers basic Math, Reading, and Science. Students may prepare for this test by going to the ATI testing site (http://www.atitesting.com/) Your unofficial TEAS 5.0 score must be submitted with your application.

2. <u>Application Process</u>:

Applications are accepted on an on-going basis. Application deadline for fall semester enrollment is February 28th. Deadline for spring semester enrollment is August 31st. Incomplete applications will NOT be accepted.

Packets must be submitted in person to Bldg. T420.

+Those students holding a bachelor's degree in another discipline from a U.S. nationally accredited institution will not be required to take any other general education requirements for the A.S. Registered Nursing degree.

3. <u>Transcript Requirement</u>: One original transcript in a sealed envelope from each college and university attended, including MiraCosta College, must be submitted with your application to the program.

- Foreign Transcripts: ALL foreign transcripts must be *evaluated* by a credential evaluation service for determining U.S. equivalency. If a foreign degree was <u>earned</u>, the evaluation must state its equivalency to a U.S. degree. Approved agencies can be found in the Admissions & Records office.
- 5. <u>Denial of Licensure</u>: The California Board of Registered Nursing may deny a license regulated by the Business and Professional Code, Section 480, on such grounds as: being convicted of a crime, acts of dishonesty, fraud or deceit. All students selected for enrollment in the nursing program will be assessed for past criminal activity prior to clinical experiences. Please contact the Program Director if you have questions.
- 6. <u>For applicants who are notified that they have been</u> <u>accepted for enrollment in the program</u> there are three additional requirements:
 - A. **Health Requirements**: Applicants selected for enrollment in the program must have a physical examination, laboratory tests, and immunizations just prior to starting the Nursing Program. The student must be free from communicable diseases, infections, and must be able to perform the essential requirements of the program with or without reasonable accommodations for disability.
 - B. **Orientation and Advisement Session:** must be attended once accepted for enrollment in the program.
 - C. ALL nursing students in ALL programs will be required to complete the background check and urine drug screen BEFORE BEGINNING THE NURSING PROGRAMS IN SAN DIEGO - THIS IS A HOSPITAL/HEALTH CARE AGENCY REQUIREMENT. Students will be given the information to obtain these requirements at the orientation and advisement. Background Check -American Data Bank (ADB) www.sdnahcbackground.com
