DIRECTIONS for signing the accompanying Will or Codicil

[You should read through the accompanying Codicil or Will carefully before signing it in accordance with the directions given below. If you are not satisfied with its contents, you need not sign the document.]

Before signing, fill in the date, in words, in the blank space left for the purpose.

Get two witnesses, who must not be persons who take any benefit under the document, or the husbands or wives of such persons.

Sign in ink, in the presence of the two witnesses.

The witnesses must sign, in your presence, put their names, addresses and occupations in the spaces indicated for the purpose.

There has been a correction on page . Both you yourself and the witnesses should initial the same in the margin.
