About the Seminar

The Labor and Employment Law Section of The Mississippi Bar will hold its annual seminar on Tuesday, April 22, at the Federal Courthouse in Jackson. The 6.0 hour CLE credit seminar, including 1 hour of ethics, will cover topics relevant to all who practice in the L&E field, or who seek broader understanding of labor and employment issues in Mississippi. The seminar will feature well-known plaintiff's and defense lawyers, a federal judge and a federal magistrate judge, and a recent Chair of the American Health Lawyers Association, all sharing their knowledge on areas ranging from case law updates to the Affordable Care Act and from employment dispute arbitration to HIPAA compliance.

During the CLE Seminar, Judge Carlton W. Reeves, United States District Court, Southern District of MS, will offer attendees a view from the bench on summary judgments and trial issues. Attendees will also benefit from a session on changes to the Federal Rule of Civil Procedure and settlement issues from Judge F. Keith Ball, United States District Court, Southern District of MS. Armin J. Moeller, Jr., Balch & Bingham LLP, and Gwen Combs, former Deputy General Counsel, The Mississippi Bar, will present the ethics hours on a lawyer's responsibility to report the unauthorized practice of law. Dinetia Newman, nationally known in her field of health care law, will discuss HIPAA, and Pepper Crutcher, wellknown for his work on the Affordable Care Act, will keep attorneys abreast of the current status of the ACA.

The seminar will be at the United States District Court, Southern District of MS, in Judge F. Keith Ball's Courtroom at 501 E. Court Street in Jackson. Registration check-in begins at 8:30. Cost is \$150 for Section Members and \$180 for Non-Section Members. Attorneys who join the L&E Section (\$15 annual fee) before the seminar will be eligible for the Section Member rate.
