PURPOSE:

The **LaMissTenn Key Club District Scholarship Program** provides the annual scholarships awarded by the LaMissTenn Key Club District and the Louisiana-Mississippi-West Tennessee Kiwanis District Foundation. The scholarships will be awarded at the LaMissTenn Key Club District Convention in April to Key Club members who have exemplified to the highest degree, the basic principles of Key Club - caring and sharing - in their homes, schools, communities, and churches. The recipients will be of high moral character and should have achieved excellence in all of their endeavors.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior, an active Key Club member for the past two years in good standing of a Key Club that is also in good standing with both the La.-Miss.-W.Tenn. District and with Key Club International.
2. The applicant must intend to enroll in a four year college or university, or in a community, technical or vocational college.
3. The overall grade point average of the applicant must be the equivalent of a 3.0 or better on a 4.0 point scale.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS: *(all information must be computer-generated)*

- Complete the Application Form, including the list of activities and leadership positions and the statement on your future, as they appear on the reverse side. The use of additional sheets of paper is acceptable.
- An original photograph for publicity purposes to your local newspapers, such as school pictures and passport photos. Personal snapshots, such as “selfies” and group pictures, and photocopies of original photographs will not be accepted.
- A copy of the official high school transcript.
- A one-page (typed, single-spaced) essay on your personal involvement and leadership experiences in Key Club.
- One letter of recommendation, originally signed and dated, from each of the following:
 - A Kiwanian, a member of the Kiwanis club that sponsors your home Key Club
 - An administrator, guidance counselor, or faculty member from your high school
 - An individual of your choice

NOTE:

It is important to remember that the enclosed form **MUST** be used for these scholarships in order to be considered. Also if all items requested are not included, the applicant may not be considered for these awards. Application materials become the property of the LaMissTenn District and will not be returned.
