## Golden West College School of Nursing January 2014



Dear Nursing Program Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the Golden West College Registered Nurse (RN) program. Based on thousands of students who have applied to the nursing program before you, we have assembled this information to help make the application process as easy as possible for you. Please read this information carefully as it will answer the majority of your questions.

## Step 1 - Qualifications

First, you need to be sure you qualify. To be eligible to apply for admission to the nursing program, you must meet the following criteria:

- Be at least 18 years of age at time of admission
- Complete the four program prerequisites Bio 220 Human Anatomy, Bio 225 Human
  Physiology, Bio 210 General Microbiology and English 100 or equivalent with a grade of "C" or
  better (Please note that the science courses must have been completed within the last 5
  years).
- Complete the on-line nursing orientation and print the confirmation page with the number on it.
   This must be attached to your application. A new on-line orientation must be completed and a new confirmation number must be obtained for each application filed.
- Submit your score from the first TEAS V exam taken within the last 365 days from the date of your application. You may print the test results from the ATI website. An official TEAS transcript from ATI is not required to be submitted with your application.
- Be in adequate health to perform the duties of a Registered Nurse. These requirements are detailed in the current college catalog (<u>www.goldenwestcollege.edu/catalog</u>). Please be sure you can meet these requirements for participation in clinical activities.
- If you are not a student at GWC, complete an application to the college, available on the website (<a href="www.goldenwestcollege.edu/admissions">www.goldenwestcollege.edu/admissions</a>). You will need a student ID to apply to the nursing program.

If you took any of the science pre-requisites outside of Region 8 community colleges you should have submitted your official transcripts to the School of Nursing in October 2013. If you did not do this, your application will not be considered. A list of the Region 8 community colleges is on the GWC Nursing Website at <a href="https://www.goldenwestcollege.edu/nursing">www.goldenwestcollege.edu/nursing</a>.

Please note: To participate in the clinical component of each nursing course, the health care agencies require each student to meet the following requirements. <u>These are all due upon acceptance</u> to the *Program:* 

- Have no criminal or civil record (a clear background check) for the last 7 years. (Please review
  the BRN website (<u>www.rn.ca.gov</u>) for background issues that would prohibit a graduated nurse from
  being allowed to take the licensing exam)
- Have a clear urine drug test this drug test must be performed prior to the beginning of the semester
- Immunizations as per current Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines
- A Social Security number or I- 9 Visa is required.
   (Please note that a Social Security number is now required by the Board of Registered Nursing to take the licensing examination.)

# Step 2 - Selection

- 1. All complete applications that are submitted by the deadline are evaluated based on the multicriteria grid. <u>Each applicant must provide their total points in the designated space on the</u> application.
- 2. All qualified applicants are ranked based on points earned in the multi-criteria. Students with the highest number of points are then randomly selected for the FALL or SPRING semester until all spaces in the program are filled. A limited number of alternate applicants are also selected.
- 3. Students who are eligible to enroll in nursing coursework must submit required paperwork by specified deadlines or their space will be given to an alternate.
- 4. Qualified applicants who are not selected for entry are encouraged to re-apply during the next application period. We do not maintain a wait-list.

# Step 3 - Filing your Application

- Application packets submitted after the deadline and incomplete applications will not be processed.
- You may turn your application into the Admission and Records
   office <u>beginning</u> January 13, through January 24, 2014. Exact hours will be posted on the
   website prior to January, 2014.
- You may mail in your complete application packet to the School of Nursing. It must be postmarked by January 24, 2014. Please mail during the application period above.

# **Step 4 – Fill out the Application**

- Fill out the 4 page application, attach requested copies, and remember to sign and date the application.
- All materials you turn in with your application will become the property of Golden West College and will not be returned to you.
- Application packets submitted after the deadline and incomplete applications will not be processed.
- There are multiple items to turn in with the application, so please use and submit the Application Checklist (on page 4 of the application).

#### Pre-Requisite EXAMPLE 1:

To calculate your GPA, multiple the number of COURSE UNITS by 4 points for an A, 3 points for a B, 2 points for a C, or 1 point for a D. Add together Course Units attempted and divide total points by total units attempted. The result will be your GPA.

If this is the case, and you did not submit your transcripts in October 2013, your application will not be reviewed.

	<b>Attach</b> the required documents for the points claimed on the multi-criteria grid. If required documentation is not attached to the application, no point will be awarded for the criterion.
	Signature on Page 3 of the application acknowledging understanding of consequences of falsifying the application.
	Complete GPA calculation ( Pg. 3) of your 4 pre-requisite classes include GPA here too
	<b>Attach</b> a copy of the TEAS V Test results, taken at any testing location within the last 365 days from January 17, 2013 (do not request an official copy of the results from <a href="www.atitesting.com">www.atitesting.com</a> at this time). We only accept the <b>FIRST</b> TEAS score taken within the last 365 days from January 17, 2013. If selected for admission with a TEAS V score below 62%, remediation will be required prior to enrolling in nursing coursework.
	<b>Attach</b> a copy of the confirmation page from the Nursing Orientation to the application. Make sure the page includes a confirmation number and you write your name on the confirmation page. The online orientation can be found at the GWC Nursing Website at <a href="https://www.goldenwestcollege.edu/nursing">www.goldenwestcollege.edu/nursing</a>
	<b>Attach</b> a copy of your High School Diploma, Transcript, or GED unless your college transcripts show a college degree (AA/BS etc.).
	Attach-UNOFFICIAL Transcripts from ALL colleges attended, even if the coursework is not being applied toward the nursing program. Please add your name and GWC student ID number to each transcript page. Note that all foreign transcripts must be translated by an official agency prior to application to the Nursing Program. This is required to evaluate equivalency of both high school education and college courses, if not translated it will not be eligible for review.
	Attach a copy of Government issued photo ID, e.g. – Driver's License, Passport photo.
	If you are a veteran, spouse or widow(er) of a veteran, <u>attach</u> a copy of the honorable discharge form to the application.
	Read the GWC catalog sections about academic regulations, graduation requirements and the Associate degree nursing program. The catalog is available on the GWC Nursing Website, at the GWC library, and for purchase in the college bookstore
