The Civilian Police Review Board for the City of Durham will hold a Public Information & Feedback Session to provide citizens with an overview of the complaint process and functions of the Board as well as to receive specific suggestions from citizens on changes to the mission, duties & responsibilities, and jurisdiction of the Board.

"We are inviting citizens of Durham to attend the session to offer specific recommendations on how the Civilian Police Review Board should operate consistent with the concerns of citizens and the statutory authority of the State of North Carolina to maintain public accountability as well as trust & confidence in the personnel of the Durham Police Department," says _____, _____ of the Civilian Police Review Board.

The purpose of the Board is to hear cases of persons claiming to be aggrieved by the results of investigations of one or more officers or

employees of the Police Department conducted by the Professional Standards Division.

The Board's mandate is to determine whether or not the investigation was conducted in an appropriate manner, specifically, whether the Police Department abused its discretion in the conduct of the investigation. The Board examines the written evidence submitted by the complainant and the Police Department to determine whether a hearing should be held.

The Board has no power to discipline, reprimand, or fire any officer or employee of the Police Department. The Board's power is limited to making recommendations whether or not a hearing is held.
