In accordance with the F-1 Student Visa requirements of the USCIS (the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services), international applicants must demonstrate proof of available funds to cover their education cost and living expenses throughout the duration of their studies in the U.S. Proof of the funds must be in the form of **an official bank statement and an official bank letter** (with bank official's contact information, signature and signing date). All bank documents must be in English. All funds must be readily accessible and liquid, such as savings accounts and checking accounts. The balance of the bank accounts must be converted to **U.S. Dollar** and **dated within six months of intended program start date**. The estimated cost for one academic year (fall and spring semester) at San Bernardino Valley College is **\$18,500**. If any of the information is unclear, additional proof may be required.
