Focus on what can cause harm and what could go wrong.	List the control methods required to eliminate, isolate or minimize the risk of injury arising from the identified hazard.

To help identify hazards for each step, ask:

- can any body part get caught in or between objects?
- can I be struck by or against anything?
- can I slip, trip or fall?
- can I strain or sprain a muscle from lifting/pulling/pushing?
- is there possible exposure to extreme heat or cold?
- is excessive noise or vibration a problem?
- is there a danger from falling objects?
- is lighting a problem?

- can weather conditions affect safety?
- can I come in contact with an energy source?
- can I come in contact with a hazardous substance?
- are there dusts, fumes or vapours in the air?
