### **AAUW - AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF UNIVERSITY WOMEN SAN LUIS OBISPO CHAPTER**

Multiple awards of varying amounts for female applicants must be planning to attend a 4-year university or college. Selection based on service, leadership, academic promise and future plans.

### **ALLYSON BREE GOVE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Applicant must be planning to attend either 2 or 4 year school to pursue a career in the field of Child Development, Education, or Counseling. Applicant must have completed the ROP Child Development Aide program (Tiny Tigers) and demonstrate the need for financial assistance.

*Attach a short statement (less than 1 page) either outlining your future plans for a career working with children or telling of a successful activity you planned for small children.*

### **AL RIZZOLI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP**

Multiple awards of varying amounts for applicants with a desire to pursue a trade or technical or vocational education to earn a career specific certificate. This scholarship is sponsored by the Rotary Club of San Luis Obispo. Applicant should have extensive experience with the vocational arts, agriculture, and/ or ROP/ CTE courses during high school. Possible work experience in area of study also considered.

*Two letters of recommendation are required.*

### **ALTRUSA INTERNATIONAL of SLO**

Two (2) \$250 scholarships for students planning to attend a 2 or 4- year college or university. Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA and community service and leadership experience.

### **AMERICAN LEGION**

Two awards @ \$500, one each for a male and female. Applicants must be planning to pursue higher learning at any college, business, or vocational school as a full-time student and demonstrate motivation and desire for advancement and opportunity. Applicants must show academic potential for success and financial need. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States. Finalists will be interviewed by sponsoring organization.

### **ARNOT/JONES ACADEMIC AWARD**

This academic award includes a perpetual plaque and a cash award. The Arnot/Jones Academic Award has been established to honor the memory of two former San Luis Obispo High School staff members: Miss Arnot, Librarian from 1929 to 1956, and Miss Jones, Latin teacher from 1924 to 1951. A cash award varies each year and winners name inscribed on permanent plaque. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or greater.

### **AUYONG FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**

At least one \$200 scholarship per year awarded to a student planning to pursue higher education at a 2 or 4 year college Applicant must have a cumulative 3.0GPA or higher and have been active in community service and school activities over the past 2 years and participated on a SLOHS athletic team

**BARNEY DEVECK CUESTA CRANKERS AUTO SCHOLARSHIP**

One (1) \$250 scholarship for student planning to continue their education in automotive industry including, but not limited to repair, restoration and engine technology. Applicant must have at least a 2.0 overall GPA with 3.0 in automotive courses.

**BLACK AND GOLD BOOSTER CLUB**

Multiple \$500 scholarships to a 2, 4- year or trade school of your choice to continue your education. Selection will be based on community service, diversity of school activities, essay quality, grades and an interview.

*With these criteria in mind, and recognizing that your high school years offer opportunities to participate in a variety of new activities, prepare an essay (no longer than one page) that explains what qualifies you for this scholarship. Applications will be read and finalists will be interviewed by a panel of Black & Gold Board members.*

**LOUIS MEMORIAL SCHOLARHIP**

Two (2) \$500 scholarships for students planning to attend a 2 or 4 year college. Highest GPA not necessarily a pre-requisite. Motivation, perseverance & character will be recognized.

**SAN LUIS OBISPO ASSOCIATION REALTOR OF THE YEAR**

In honor of the 2010 Realtor of the Year – Either two (2) \$750 scholarships or one (1) \$1500 scholarship will be awarded. Applicants must be planning to enter a 2 or 4 year college upon graduation and planning to major in real estate, marketing, business or some other allied field. One (1) \$1,000 scholarship for a student who must have taken at least 3 years of mathematics and at least 2 years of laboratory science. Applicant should have established need of financial assistance.
