

## ROUTES TO SHOW SITE

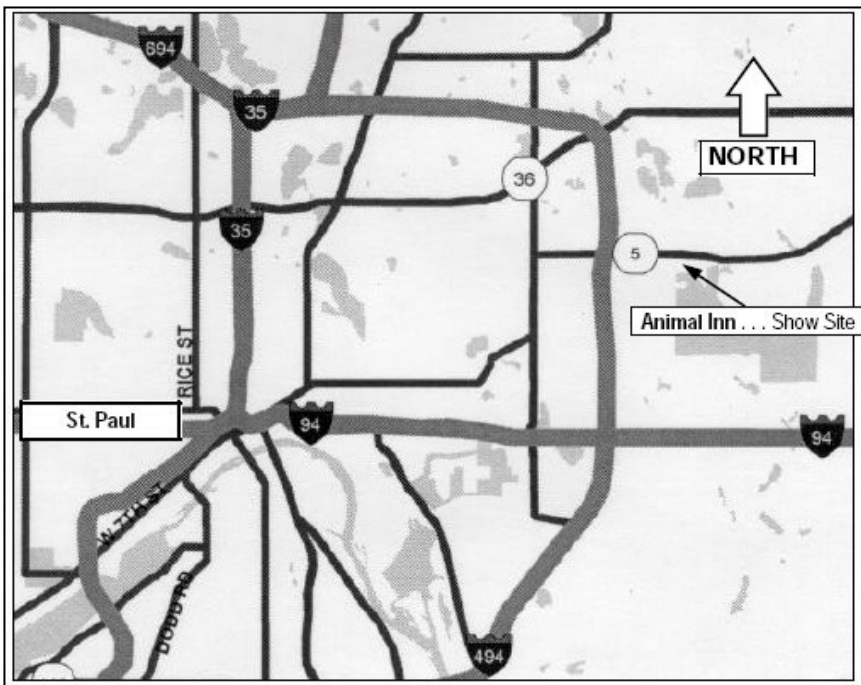
### Directions to Animal Inn Show Center

FROM THE SOUTH: I-35 to I-35E at the split. I-494 East and North to Highway 5. Highway 5 East to Animal Inn on the right. OR Highway 10 and 61 to I-494, then follow previous directions.

FROM THE EAST: I-94 TO I-694, I-694 North to Highway 5 and follow previous directions.

**Bred-By-Exhibitor Classes** The person handling a dog in the Bred By Exhibitor class must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record. Chapter 3, Section 8 AKC Rules Applying To Dog Shows. (Effective January 1, 2005)

### JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP—MASTER CLASS.

This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any Junior Showmanship class at the show
